Agenda:

2022154 W. Bangsund: THAT the Meeting Agenda be adopted as circulated.

2022155 J. Louison: THAT the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Council of the Town of Broadview held Wednesday the 20th day of July 2022 be approved as circulated. CARRIED.

Service Sewer Line to 938 Edmonton Street to be Repaired:

Pump Houses for Raw Water Feeder Wells to be Removed and Replaced with Pitless Adapters:

Ottenbreit: THAT with one of the pump houses that was over one of the two raw water feeder wells getting blown off in one of the high wind events this summer that the Public Works Foreman be authorized to proceed with installing pitless. adapters on both of the raw feeder wells eliminating the need for the pump houses. Town to Express Concern to SaskPower's of the Vigor of the Power Poles on Main Street:

2022159 S. Markwart: THAT the Town of Broadview express its concerns to SaskPower with regards to SaskPower's power poles on Main Street in Town appearing to have lost their vigor.

Delegation: S/Sgt Dallyn Holmstrom with the Broadview Detachment of the RCMP (7:19 a.m. to 7:39 a.m.) Dallyn introduced himself to Council as he had just started on Monday, August 15, 2022 as S/Sgt of the Broadview Detachment, Dallyn stated he had ran the stats for Broadview and the stats reflected that the calls in Broadview are low compared to other Towns which have seen a significant increase in break and enter calls in particular, Dallyn encouraged members of Council to call him if they have any questions or concerns, that the RCMP intend to return to making visits to the local schools, concerns with lack of detachment members living in Broadview was raised with Dallyn as was the need for the detachment members to maintain Community involvement which Dallyn stated was a National Priority of the RCMP.

Public Works Foreman: Bowman Bryant (7:34 a.m. to 7:53 a.m.) Bowman was introduced to S/Sgt Dallyn Holmstrom, after S/Sgt Holmstrom had excused himself from Council Chambers Bowman discussed the cleaning and videoing of the Town's sewer line mains, installing pitless adapters on the raw water feeder wells to eliminate need for the pump house buildings over them, the summer employees and how well they have worked out this year.

Post Request for Proposals for Landscape Architectural Services to Develop Master Plan for Memory Park to Wildlife Land Pathway:

Ottenbreit: THAT with the Town of Broadview being approved for funding from the Permanent Public Transit Program -Active Transportation program to develop a Master Plan for a Linking Pathway - Memory Park to Museum to Wildlife Lands that the Town of Broadview post a Request for Proposals (RFP) on SaskTenders inviting proposals for Landscape Architectural Services of these three community spaces in Broadview, Saskatchewan to develop a Master Plan incorporating and connecting each of the three spaces together within an appropriate pathway from community consultation with the RFP to require that the firm or individual needs to be have Membership in the Saskatchewan Association of Landscape Architects and the contract will be awarded on a value for money basis with 50% being on the bases of overall proposal and 50% on the proposed cost.
